

The Changing Landscape at Rye's Young and International Gallery



Open for less than a year, AiBo Gallery on Purdy Avenue has more walk-in visitors than all the Rye nail salons combined. When the Chamber of Commerce hands out its next round of awards, the gallery deserves one for Beautification. Owner Glenn Aber took an empty storefront and transformed it.
